10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 3, chapter 64 of the Code of  
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the  
12 Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a  
13 legislative rule relating to permits for construction and  
14 major modification of major stationary sources for the  
15 prevention of significant deterioration of air quality.

16 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

17 That article 3, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,  
18 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

19 **ARTICLE 3. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL**  
20 **PROTECTION TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

21 **§64-3-1. Department of Environmental Protection.**

22 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 22,  
23 2013, authorized under the authority of section four, article five,

1 chapter twenty-two, of this code, modified by the Department of  
2 Environmental Protection to meet the objections of the Legislative  
3 Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on  
4 September 4, 2013, relating to the Department of Environmental  
5 Protection (permits for construction and major modification of  
6 major stationary sources for the prevention of significant  
7 deterioration of air quality, [45 CSR 14](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule relating to permits for construction and major modification of major stationary sources for the prevention of significant deterioration of air quality.

This section is new; therefore, it has been completely underscored.
