A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology
to promulgate a legislative rule relating to speech-language
pathology and audiology assistants.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and
Audiology.**

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 25,
2013, authorized under the authority of section seven, article

1 thirty-two, chapter thirty of this code, modified by the Board of
2 Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology to meet the
3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and
4 refiled in the State Register on November 26, 2013, relating to the
5 Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology
6 (speech-language pathology and audiology assistants, [29 CSR 2](#)), is
7 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Speech-language Pathology and Audiology Assistants.
