A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by  
adding thereto a new section, designated §4-2A-11, relating to  
reducing compensation of state legislators.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended  
by adding thereto a new section, designated §4-2A-11, to read as  
follows:

**ARTICLE 2A. COMPENSATION FOR AND EXPENSES OF MEMBERS OF THE  
LEGISLATURE.**

**§4-2A-11. Compensation for members of the Legislature limited.**

Notwithstanding other provisions of this code to the contrary,  
and subject to constitutional requirements, the salary of state  
legislators shall be limited to \$18,000 annually.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to reduce legislators' compensation to an annual salary of \$18,000.

This section is new; therefore, it has been completely underscored.
