



1 entered into by a consumer for the purchase or lease of goods or  
2 services in consumer transactions, whether for the rental of space  
3 to be occupied for residential purposes or for the sale of goods or  
4 services for personal, family, household or agricultural purposes,  
5 must have as a separate and standalone document the waiver of the  
6 consumer's right to a trial by jury.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require all written agreements that contain a waiver of a consumer's right to a trial by jury on a claim involving death to have the waiver form as a separate document from the rest of the written agreement.
