L O	A BILL to amend and reenact §17C-7-1 of the Code of West Virginia,
L1	1931, as amended, relating to operating a motor vehicle in the

L 4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
L 5	That \$17C-7-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
L 6	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
L 7	ARTICLE 7. DRIVING ON RIGHT SIDE OF ROADWAY, OVERTAKING AND
L 8	PASSING, ETC.
L 9	§17C-7-1. Driving on right side of roadway; exceptions; penalty.
20	(a) Upon all roadways of sufficient width a vehicle shall be
21	driven upon the right half of the roadway, except as follows:
22	(1) When overtaking and passing another vehicle proceeding in
23	the same direction under the rules governing such movement;
24	(2) When the right half of a roadway is closed to traffic
25	while under construction or repair:

- 1 (3) Upon a roadway divided into three marked lanes for traffic 2 under the rules applicable thereon; or
- 3 (4) Upon a roadway designated and signposted for one-way 4 traffic.
- 5 (b) Upon all roadways any vehicle proceeding at less than the 6 normal speed of traffic at the time and place and under the 7 conditions then existing shall be driven in the right-hand lane 8 then available for traffic, or as close as practicable to the 9 right-hand curb or edge of the roadway, except when overtaking and 10 passing another vehicle proceeding in the same direction or when 11 preparing for a left turn at an intersection or into a private road 12 or driveway.
- 13 (c) <u>Upon a controlled-access highway</u>, a person may not operate
 14 a vehicle in the left lane, except:
- (1) When overtaking and passing another vehicle;
- 16 (2) When no other vehicle is directly behind the vehicle in
- 17 the left lane;
- 18 (3) When traffic conditions and congestion make it impractical
- 19 to drive in the right lane;
- 20 (4) When snow and other inclement weather conditions make it

- 11 (c) (d) Any person violating the provisions of this section is
- 12 guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be
- 13 fined not more than \$100; upon a second conviction within one year
- 14 thereafter, shall be fined not more than \$200; and upon a third or
- 15 subsequent conviction, shall be fined not more than \$500.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to establish specifically when it is permissible to operate a motor vehicle in the left lane on a controlled-access highway.
