NOTE**

A BILL to amend of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by
adding thereto a new section, designated §17A-3-14a, relating
to authorizing the issuance of special "Homeland Security and
Emergency Management" registration plates.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
by adding thereto a new section, designated §17A-3-14a, to read as
follows:

**ARTICLE 3. ORIGINAL AND RENEWAL OF REGISTRATION; ISSUANCE OF
CERTIFICATES OF TITLE.**

**§17A-3-14a. Issuance of special "Homeland Security and Emergency
Management" plates.**

(a) Notwithstanding the limitations contained in section
fourteen of this article, the division may issue special
registration plates that read "Homeland Security and Emergency

1 Management".

2 (b) Upon appropriate application, the division may issue the
3 special registration plate, which features a West Virginia Division
4 of Homeland Security and Emergency Management insignia for any
5 number of vehicles titled in the name of the applicant.

6 (c) The division shall charge a special initial application
7 fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by law for a
8 registration plate issued under this section. The fee shall be
9 collected by the division and deposited in the State Road Fund.

10 (d) An annual fee of \$15 shall be charged for each plate in
11 addition to all other fees required by this chapter.

12 (e) The provisions of subsections (a), (b), (d), (g), (h) and
13 (i) of section fourteen of this section apply in the issuance of
14 plates under this section.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the issuance of special "Homeland Security and Emergency Management" registration plates.

This section is new; therefore, it has been completely underscored.
