10	A BILL to amend and reenact $\$29-25-22$ of the Code of West Virginia,
11	1931, as amended, relating to the creation of a Historic
12	Resort Hotel Employee Retirement Fund within the Historic
13	Resort Hotel Fund in the State Treasury; reducing the amount
14	of net income paid by the Historic Resort Hotel Fund to the
15	General Revenue Fund from sixty-four percent to sixty percent;
16	and designating that four percent of net income of the
17	Historic Resort Hotel Fund be paid to the Historic Resort
18	Hotel Employee Retirement Fund.
19	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
20	That §29-25-22 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
21	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
22	ARTICLE 25. AUTHORIZED GAMING FACILITY.
23	§29-25-22. Historic Resort Hotel Fund; allocation of adjusted
24	gross receipts; disposition of license fees.

- 1 (a) There is hereby created a special fund in the State
 2 Treasury which shall be designated and known as the Historic Resort
 3 Hotel Fund. Thirty-six percent of the gross terminal income
 4 received by the commission under section twenty of this article and
 5 thirty percent of the adjusted gross receipts received by the
 6 commission under section twenty-one of this article shall be
 7 deposited with the State Treasurer and placed in the Historic
 8 Resort Hotel Fund. The fund shall be an interest-bearing account
 9 with interest to be credited to and deposited in the Historic
 10 Resort Hotel Fund.
- 11 (b) All expenses of the commission shall be paid from the
 12 Historic Resort Hotel Fund, including reimbursement of the State
 13 Police for activities performed at the request of the commission in
 14 connection with background investigations or enforcement activities
 15 pursuant to this article. At no time may the commission's expenses
 16 under this article exceed fifteen percent of the total of the
 17 annual revenue received from the licensee under this article,
 18 including all license fees, taxes or other amounts required to be
 19 deposited in the Historic Resort Hotel Fund.
- (c) An Historic Resort Hotel Modernization Fund is hereby created within the Historic Resort Hotel Fund. For all fiscal years beginning on or after July 1, 2011, the commission shall deduct two and one-half percent from gross terminal income received by the commission under section twenty of this article for the fiscal year

2 account maintained within the Historic Resort Hotel Modernization 3 Fund for each historic resort hotel. For each dollar expended by a 4 historic resort hotel for video lottery or table gaming facility 5 modernization improvements at the historic resort hotel, having a 6 useful life of three or more years and placed in service after 7 April 1, 2011, the historic resort hotel shall receive \$1 in 8 recoupment from its facility modernization account. For purposes of 9 this section, the term "video lottery or table gaming facility 10 modernization improvements" include acquisition of computer 11 hardware and software, communications and Internet 12 equipment, security and surveillance equipment, video lottery 13 terminals and other electronic equipment or other equipment 14 designed to modernize the facility. 15 (d) A Historic Resort Hotel Employee Retirement Fund is 16 created within the Historic Resort Hotel Fund. For all fiscal years 17 beginning on or after July 1, 2014, the commission shall deduct 18 four percent from gross terminal income received by the commission 19 under section twenty of this article for the fiscal year and 20 deposit these amounts into a separate employee retirement account 21 maintained within the Historic Resort Hotel Employee Retirement 22 Fund for each historic resort hotel. Moneys within the Historic 23 Resort Hotel Employee Retirement Fund shall be used to provide 24 matching funds for retirement accounts, pursuant to 26 U.S.C. §

1 and deposit these amounts into a separate facility modernization

- 1 401(k), of historic resort hotel employees.
- 2 (d) (e) The balance of the Historic Resort Hotel Fund shall 3 become net income and shall be divided as follows:
- 4 (1) Sixty-four Sixty percent of the Historic Resort Hotel Fund 5 net income shall be paid into the General Revenue Fund to be 6 appropriated by the Legislature;
- 7 (2) Nineteen percent of the Historic Resort Hotel Fund net 8 income shall be paid into the State Debt Reduction Fund established 9 in section twenty-seven, article twenty-two-c of this chapter to be 10 appropriated by the Legislature;
- (3) Four percent of the Historic Resort Hotel Fund net income

 12 shall be paid into the Historic Resort Hotel Employee Retirement

 13 Fund created in subsection (d) of this section;
- 14 (3) (4) The Tourism Promotion Fund established in section 15 twelve, article two, chapter five-b of this code shall receive 16 three percent of the Historic Resort Hotel Fund net income;
- 17 (4) (5) The county where the gaming facility is located shall
 18 receive four percent of the Historic Resort Hotel Fund net income;
 19 (5) (6) The municipality where the gaming facility is located
 20 or the municipality closest to the gaming facility by paved road
 21 access as of the effective date of the reenactment of this section
 22 by the 2009 regular session of the Legislature shall receive two
 23 and one-half percent of the Historic Resort Hotel Fund net income;
 24 (6) (7) The municipalities within the county where the gaming

- 15 (5) (6) and (6) (7) of this subsection shall receive equal shares
- 16 of two and one-half percent of the Historic Resort Hotel Fund net
- 17 income: Provided, That funds transferred to municipalities under
- 18 this subdivision shall be are used only to pay for debt reduction
- 19 in municipal police and fire pension funds and the costs of
- 20 infrastructure improvements and other capital improvements.
- 21 (e) (f) Notwithstanding any provision of this article to the
- 22 contrary, all limited gaming facility license fees and license
- 23 renewal fees received by the commission pursuant to section nine of
- 24 this article shall be deposited into the Community-Based Service

- $\frac{f}{g}$ With the exception of the license fees and license
- 4 renewal fees received by the commission pursuant to section nine of
- 5 this article, all revenues received from licensees and license
- 6 applicants under this article shall be retained by the commission
- 7 as reimbursement for the licensing process.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to create a Historic Resort Hotel Employee Retirement Fund within the Historic Resort Hotel Fund in the State Treasury, reduce the amount of net income of the Historic Resort Hotel Fund being paid to the General Revenue Fund from sixty-four percent to sixty percent, and designate that four percent of net income of the Historic Resort Hotel Fund be paid to the Historic Resort Hotel Employee Retirement Fund.
