10 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by
11 adding thereto a new section, designated §20-5-19a, relating
12 to providing a fifty-percent discount to members of the West
13 Virginia National Guard and the West Virginia National Guard
14 Reserve in campground rental fees in state parks.

15 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

16 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
17 by adding thereto a new section, designated §20-5-19a, to read as
18 follows:

19 **ARTICLE 5. PARKS AND RECREATION.**

20 **§20-5-19a. Discounts for members of the West Virginia National
21 Guard and the West Virginia Reserves.**

22 The director shall issue a discount card to members of the
23 West Virginia National Guard and members of the West Virginia

1 Reserves which provides a fifty percent reduction in campground
2 rental fees for each campsite to be used exclusively by the
3 eligible camper. In order to be eligible for the reduction, the
4 person shall document that he or she is a member of the West
5 Virginia National Guard or the West Virginia Reserves. The
6 director shall promulgate rules in accordance with article three,
7 chapter twenty-nine-a of this code setting forth the documentation
8 that is necessary to prove that an individual is a member of the
9 West Virginia National Guard or the West Virginia Reserves.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide a fifty percent discount to members of the West Virginia National Guard and the West Virginia Reserves in campground rental fees in state parks. The bill also provides for rulemaking.

§20-5-19a is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
