22	§11-13B-1. Tax imposed on telecommunications businesses.
23	(a) Upon every telecommunications business selling or

- 2 service, there is hereby imposed an annual privilege tax on account
- 3 of the business or other activities of the taxpayer, engaged in or
- 4 carried on within this state, during the taxable year. The amount

19 §11-13B-2. Proceeds of the tax.

- 20 Proceeds from the tax imposed by this article shall be paid to
- 21 the West Virginia Division of Tourism to be used for the promotion
- 22 and maintenance of outdoor activities including, but not limited
- 23 to, skiing and white water rafting.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to create a tax on telecommunications businesses to provide as close as reasonably possible, \$10 million in revenue to benefit promotion and maintenance of outdoor activities.
