2 Senate. The person appointed by the commission shall continue to
3 serve until appointed or replaced by the Governor's appointee. The
4 term of appointment shall be for four years, mirroring the
5 Governor's normal four-year term of office.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require that the director of the Consumer Advocate Division of the Public Service Commission be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate.
