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A BILL to repeal §21-5A-1, §21-5A-2, §21-5A-3, §21-5A-5, §21-5A-6,  
§21-5A-7, §21-5A-8, §21-5A-9, §21-5A-10 and §21-5A-11 of the  
Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, all relating to  
repealing the prevailing hourly rate of wages requirements by  
or on the behalf of public authorities engaged in the  
construction of public improvements.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That §21-5A-1, §21-5A-2, §21-5A-3, §21-5A-5, §21-5A-6,  
§21-5A-7, §21-5A-8, §21-5A-9, §21-5A-10 and §21-5A-11 of the Code  
of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be repealed.

**ARTICLE 5A. WAGES FOR CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS.**

**§1. Repeal of the article relating to the prevailing hourly rate  
of wages requirements by or on the behalf of public**

1           **authorities engaged in the construction of public**  
2           **improvements.**

3           That §21-5A-1, §21-5A-2, §21-5A-3, §21-5A-5, §21-5A-6,  
4 §21-5A-7, §21-5A-8, §21-5A-9, §21-5A-10, §21-5A-11 of the Code of  
5 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be repealed.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to repeal the article requiring public authorities engaged in the construction of public improvements to pay the prevailing hourly rate of wages. The bill also repeals other provisions associated with that requirement.

§21-5A-1, §21-5A-2, §21-5A-3, §21-5A-5, §21-5A-6, §21-5A-7, §21-5A-8, §21-5A-9, §21-5A-10, §21-5A-11 are repealed.
