

**Senate Bill No. 365**

(By Senators Miller, Snyder and Williams)

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[Introduced January 16, 2014; referred to the Committee on  
Government Organization; and then to the Committee on the  
Judiciary.]  
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11 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by  
12 adding thereto a new section, designated §6B-2-5c, relating to  
13 providing an exception to certain provisions of the West  
14 Virginia Ethics Act for elected conservation district  
15 supervisors who participate in the West Virginia Conservation  
16 Agency Agricultural Enhancement Program.

17 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

18 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended  
19 by adding thereto a new section, designated §6B-2-5c, to read as  
20 follows:

21 **ARTICLE 2. WEST VIRGINIA ETHICS COMMISSION; POWERS AND DUTIES;**  
22 **DISCLOSURE OF FINANCIAL INTEREST BY PUBLIC**  
23 **OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES; APPEARANCES BEFORE PUBLIC**

1                   **AGENCIES; CODE OF CONDUCT FOR ADMINISTRATIVE LAW**  
2                   **JUDGES.**

3 **§6B-2-5c. Exception.**

4           The provisions of section five of this article do not apply to  
5 elected Conservation District Supervisors and their immediate  
6 family when the elected Conservation District Supervisor is  
7 participating in the West Virginia Conservation Agency Agricultural  
8 Enhancement Program: *Provided*, That the elected Conservation  
9 District Supervisor does not consider, act or vote on matters that  
10 affect the elected Conservation District Supervisor or his or her  
11 immediate family.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide an exception to certain provisions of the West Virginia Ethics Act for elected Conservation District Supervisors who participate in the West Virginia Conservation Agency Agricultural Enhancement Program.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
