11	A BILL to amend and reenact \$17F-1-3 of the Code of West Virginia,
12	1931, as amended, relating to authorization and regulation of
13	unlicensed off-road motorcycles upon public streets, roads and
14	highways by cities and counties within the Hatfield-McCoy
15	recreation area.
16	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
17	That \$17F-1-3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
18	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
19	ARTICLE 1. REGULATION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES.
20	§17F-1-3. Local government authority to regulate.
21	Notwithstanding any provision of this article to the contrary:
22	(1) The governing body of a municipality may regulate in any
23	manner or prohibit, by lawfully enacted ordinance, the operation of

- 1 all-terrain vehicles upon any street, road or avenue within the 2 municipal corporate limits.
- 3 (2) Homeowner associations may petition the county commission
 4 of the county in which the area regulated by the homeowner
 5 association is located for an ordinance to regulate or prohibit the
 6 operation of all-terrain vehicles upon any street, road or avenue
 7 within the area regulated by the homeowner association. County
 8 commissions are hereby authorized, upon receipt of a petition
 9 authorized by the provisions of this section, to enact an ordinance
 10 regulating or prohibiting the operation of all-terrain vehicles.
- 11 (3) The county commission of any county which has in effect
 12 and is operating under a countywide comprehensive plan may by
 13 lawfully enacted ordinance regulate or prohibit the operation of
 14 all-terrain vehicles on any road in the county, except interstate
 15 highways: *Provided*, That any county which enacts any such
 16 ordinance shall notify the West Virginia state police and all
 17 law-enforcement agencies in the county of its action in writing,
 18 together with a copy of the ordinance.
- 19 <u>(4) The governing body of a municipality located within a</u>
 20 <u>county participating in the Hatfield-McCoy recreational trail</u>
 21 <u>project may regulate in any manner the use of unlicensed off-road</u>
 22 <u>motorcycles operated in compliance with legislative rules</u>
 23 <u>promulgated by the Hatfield-McCoy Regional Recreation Authority</u>
 24 upon any street, road or avenue within the municipal corporate

- 2 (5) The county commission of a county participating in the
- 3 Hatfield-McCoy recreational trail project may regulate in any
- 4 manner the use of unlicensed off-road motorcycles operated in
- 5 compliance with legislative rules promulgated by the Hatfield-McCoy
- 6 Regional Recreation Authority on any road in the county, except
- 7 interstate highways: Provided, That any county which enacts any
- 8 such ordinance shall notify the West Virginia State Police and all
- 9 law-enforcement agencies in the county of its action in writing,
- 10 together with a copy of the ordinance.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize and regulate unlicensed off road motorcycles upon public streets, roads and highways by cities and counties within the Hatfield-McCoy recreation area. The current code allows cities and counties to permit and regulate all-terrain vehicles upon public streets, roads and highways, but not unlicensed off-road motorcycles. The amendment would allow counties and cities within the Hatfield McCoy recreation area to permit and regulate unlicensed off-road motorcycles upon public streets, roads and highways, but only if they are properly permitted by the Hatfield-McCoy Regional Recreation Authority.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
