- 17 §19-20C-3. Rulemaking; annual report.
- 18 (a) The commissioner shall propose <u>emergency or legislative</u>
 19 rules for legislative approval in accordance with article three,
 20 chapter twenty-nine-a of this code to implement the provisions of
 21 this article.
- 22 (b) Rules promulgated under this section shall, at a minimum:
- 23 (1) Identify the types of nonprofit organizations and programs

- 1 that qualify for spay neuter grants;
- 2 (2) Establish parameters for spay neuter grants;
- 3 (3) Establish procedures and requirements for grant 4 applications; and
- 5 (4) Establish administration, record-keeping and reporting 6 requirements for nonprofit organizations and programs that receive 7 spay neuter grants.
- 8 (c) Beginning the year following the program's inception, the 9 commissioner shall file an annual report with the Joint Committee 10 on Government and Finance regarding the program, funds received and 11 grants awarded, the number of dogs and cats sterilized and other 12 pertinent data.
