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10	A BILL to amend and reenact §11-8-9 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
11	extending the time of meetings of local levying bodies when meetings are delayed due to
12	circumstances beyond the control of a local levying body; providing when the Secretary of
13	State is authorized to extend the time of meetings of local levying bodies; and authorizing
14	the Secretary of State to adopt procedures and rules for approving extending time to meet as
15	a levying body.
16	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
17	That §11-8-9 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted
18	to read as follows:
19	ARTICLE 8. LEVIES.
20	§11-8-9. Meetings of local levying bodies.
21	(a) Each local levying body shall hold a meeting or meetings between the seventh and
22	twenty-eighth days of March for the transaction of business generally and particularly for the
23	business herein required.

- 1 (b) When a levy is placed on the ballot for consideration during a primary election, each 2 local levying body may extend its time to meet as a levying body until June 1 of that year.
- (c) If a local levying body is unable to meet during the times set out in subsection (a) of this

 section due to any circumstance beyond the control of a local levying body, such as fire, weather,

 natural disaster, or if the meeting place becomes unusable without notice due to utility failure,

 building damages, other sufficient cause or other emergency, the levying body may apply to the

 Secretary of State for permission to extend the time to meet as a levying body, within sixty days of

 the deadline. The Secretary of State shall propose rules for legislative approval in accordance with

 article three, chapter twenty-nine-a of this code to implement the purposes of this subsection. The

 proposed rules shall include a procedure for a local levying body to apply for permission to extend

 the time to meet as a levying body, requiring the local levying body to cite the reason a timely

 meeting was not held and that the meeting, if approved by the Secretary of State, be held in

 compliance with article nine-a, chapter six of this code relating to open governmental proceedings

 at a time set by the Secretary of State.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide a procedure for extending the time of meetings of local levying bodies when meetings are delayed because of circumstances beyond the control of a local levying body. The Secretary of State is authorized to extend the time of meetings of local levying bodies within sixty days of the original deadline and to adopt procedures and rules for approving extending time to meet as a levying body.
