15	ARTICLE 8. COMPULSORY SCHOOL ATTENDANCE.
16	§18-8-1b. Compulsory attendance in school until eighteen years of age.
17	Notwithstanding any provision of this code to the contrary, all students in this state who are
18	attending a school must attend that school until the age of eighteen. However, this section does not
19	apply to students who are exempt from school attendance for a reason other than age.
	NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require students to attend school until the age of eighteen.
