12	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:	
13	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new	
14	section, designated §11-21-10b, to read as follows:	
15	ARTICLE 21. PERSONAL INCOME TAX.	
16	<u>§11-21-10b. Tax credit for certain volunteer firefighters.</u>	
17	Any volunteer firefighter who has up-to-date credentials for the taxable year and has	
18	responded to at least five verified calls in the year is entitled to a credit against his or her personal	
19	income tax for that year in the amount of \$500.	

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide a \$500 tax credit to volunteer firefighters who have responded to at least five verified calls in a year.
