10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
11 relating to authorizing the Family Protection Services Board to promulgate a legislative rule
12 relating to perpetrator intervention programs licensure.

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

14 That article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and
15 reenacted to read as follows:

16 **ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN**
17 **RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

18 **§64-5-1. Family Protection Services Board.**

19 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 30, 2014, authorized under the
20 authority of section four hundred three, article twenty-six, chapter forty-eight, of this code, modified
21 by the Family Protection Services Board to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making
22 Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on December 17, 2014, relating to the Family

- 1 Protection Services Board (perpetrator intervention programs licensure, [191 CSR 3](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Family Protection Services Board to promulgate a legislative rule relating to perpetrator intervention programs licensure.
