14	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new
15	section, designated §20-2-20a, to read as follows:
16	ARTICLE 2. WILDLIFE RESOURCES.
17	§20-2-20a. Trapping coyote.
18	Notwithstanding any other provision of this code or rule to the contrary, a person trapping
19	coyote is not required to check the traps more than once every seventy-two hours.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide that persons trapping coyote need only check traps once every seventy- two hours.
