10	A BILL to amend and reenact §61-8-19a of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
11	to increasing the criminal penalties for participating in an animal fighting venture.
12	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
13	That §61-8-19a of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted
14	to read as follows:
15	ARTICLE 8. CRIMES AGAINST CHASTITY, MORALITY AND DECENCY.
16	§61-8-19a. Animal fighting ventures prohibited.
17	(a) It is unlawful for any person to engage in, be employed at, or sell an admission to any
18	animal fighting venture.
19	(b) Any person who violates the provisions of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor felony
20	and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not less than $\$100$ $\$1,000$ and not more than $\$1,000$
21	\$25,000, or confined in the county jail imprisoned in a state correctional facility not exceeding less
22	than one year, nor more than ten years or both so fined and confined imprisoned and may be divested
23	of ownership and control of such animals, and be liable for all costs for their care and maintenance:

- 1 Provided, That if the animal is a wild animal, game animal or fur-bearing animal, as defined in
- 2 section two, article one, chapter twenty of this code, or wildlife not indigenous to West Virginia, or
- 3 of a canine, feline, porcine, bovine, or equine species whether wild or domesticated, the person who
- 4 violates the provisions of this section is guilty of a felony and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined
- 5 not less than \$1,000 \(\frac{\$25,000}{} \) and not more than \$\frac{\$5,000}{} \) \$\(\frac{\$50,000}{} \), and imprisoned in a state
- 6 correctional facility for not less than one five nor more than five fifteen years, or both fined and

7 imprisoned.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to increase the penalties for participating in an animal fighting venture.
