6		FISCAL NOTE
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10	A BILL to amend and reenact §17C-7-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating	
11	to operating a motor vehicle in the left lane of a controlled-access highway; and	
12	misdemeanor penalty.	
13	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:	
14	That §17C-7-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted	
15	to read as follows:	
16	ARTICLE 7. DRIVING ON RIGHT SIDE OF ROADWAY, OVERTAKING AND	
17	PASSING, ETC.	
18	§17C-7-1. Driving on right side of roadway; exceptions; penalty.	
19	(a) Upon all roadways of sufficient width a vehicle shall be driven upon the right half of the	
20	roadway, except as follows:	
21	(1) When overtaking and passing another vehicle proceeding in the same direction under the	
22	rules governing such movement;	

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(2) When the right half of a roadway is closed to traffic while under construction or repair;(3) Upon a roadway divided into three marked lanes for traffic under the rules applicable

3 thereon; or

4 (4) Upon a roadway designated and signposted for one-way traffic.

5 (b) Upon all roadways any vehicle proceeding at less than the normal speed of traffic at the 6 time and place and under the conditions then existing shall be driven in the right-hand lane then 7 available for traffic, or as close as practicable to the right-hand curb or edge of the roadway, except 8 when overtaking and passing another vehicle proceeding in the same direction or when preparing 9 for a left turn at an intersection or into a private road or driveway.

(c) Upon a controlled-access highway, a person may not operate a vehicle in the left lane, except:

12 (1) When overtaking and passing another vehicle;

13 (2) When no other vehicle is directly behind the vehicle in the left lane;

14 (3) When traffic conditions and congestion make it impractical to drive in the right lane;

- 15 (4) When snow and other inclement weather conditions make it necessary to drive in the left
- 16 <u>lane;</u>
- 17 (5) When obstructions or hazards exist in the right lane;
- 18 (6) When a vehicle changes lanes to comply with a law of this state;
- 19 (7) When, because of highway design, a vehicle must be driven in the left lane when
- 20 preparing to exit;
- 21 (8) On toll highways when necessary to pay a toll or use a pass;
- 22 (9) When driving in the left lane is required to comply with an official traffic control device;

1 (10) To avoid law-enforcement vehicles, ambulances, and other emergency vehicles engaged

2 in official duties; or

- 3 (11) To avoid vehicles engaged in highway maintenance and construction operations.
- 4 (c) (d) Any person violating the provisions of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and,
 5 upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not more than \$100; upon a second conviction within one
 6 year thereafter, shall be fined not more than \$200; and upon a third or subsequent conviction, shall
 7 be fined not more than \$500.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to establish specifically when it is permissible to operate a motor vehicle in the left lane on a controlled-access highway.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
