HEALTH PROFESSIONALS STUDENT LOAN PROGRAMS. 17 §18C-3-4. Nursing Scholarship Program; Center for Nursing Fund; administration; 18 scholarship awards; service requirements. 19 (a) There is continued in the State Treasury a special revenue account known as the "Center 20 for Nursing Fund" to be administered by the commission to implement the provisions of this section and article seven-b, chapter thirty of this code. Any moneys in the account on the effective date of 22 this section are transferred to the commission's administrative authority. Balances remaining in the

- 1 fund at the end of the fiscal year do not expire or revert to the general revenue. All costs associated
- 2 with the administration of this section and article seven-b, chapter thirty of this code shall be paid
- 3 from the Center for Nursing Fund under the direction of the Vice Chancellor for Administration.
- 4 Administrative costs are to be minimized and the maximum amount feasible is to be used to fund
- 5 awards for students in nursing programs.
- 6 (b) The account is funded from the following sources:
- 7 (1) A supplemental licensure fee, not to exceed \$10 per year, to be paid by all nurses licensed
- 8 by the Board of Examiners for Registered Professional Nurses, pursuant to section eight-a, article
- 9 seven, chapter thirty of this code, and the Board of Examiners for Licensed Practical Nurses,
- 10 pursuant to section seven-a, article seven-a, chapter thirty of this code;
- 11 (2) Repayments, including interest as set by the Vice Chancellor for Administration, collected
- 12 from recipients who fail to practice or teach in West Virginia under the terms of the scholarship
- 13 agreement; and
- 14 (3) Any other funds from any source as may be added to the account.
- 15 (c) In consultation with the board of directors of the West Virginia Center for Nursing,
- 16 established pursuant to article seven-b, chapter thirty of this code, the commission shall administer
- 17 a scholarship, designated the "Nursing Scholarship Program", designed to benefit nurses who
- 18 practice in hospitals and other health care institutions or teach in state nursing programs.
- 19 (1) Awards are available for students enrolled in accredited nursing programs in West
- 20 Virginia. A recipient shall execute an agreement to fulfill a service requirement or repay the amount
- 21 of any award received.
- 22 (2) Awards are made as follows, subject to the rule required by this section:

- 1 (A) An award for any student may not exceed the full cost of education for program 2 completion;
- 3 (B) An award of up to \$3,000 is available for a student in a licensed practical nurse education 4 program. A recipient is required to practice nursing in West Virginia for one year following program 5 completion;
- 6 (C) An award of up to \$7,500 is available for a student who has completed one-half of a 7 registered nurse education program. A recipient is required to teach or practice nursing in West 8 Virginia for two years following program completion.
- 9 (D) An award of up to \$15,000 is available to a student in a nursing education master's degree 10 program or a doctoral nursing or education program. A recipient is required to teach in West 11 Virginia for two years following program completion.
- 12 (E) An award of up to \$1,000 per year is available for a student obtaining a licensed practical nurse teaching certificate. A recipient is required to teach in West Virginia for one year per award received.
- 15 (d) An award recipient shall satisfy one of the following conditions:
- 16 (1) Fulfill the service requirement pursuant to this section and the legislative rule; or
- 17 (2) Repay the commission for the amount awarded, together with accrued interest as 18 stipulated in the service agreement.
- (e) The commission shall promulgate a rule for legislative approval pursuant to article three-a, chapter twenty-nine-a of this code to implement and administer this section. The Legislature finds that an emergency exists, and, therefore, the commission shall propose an emergency rule pursuant to article three-a, chapter twenty-nine-a of this code by August 1, 2014. The rules rule shall

- 1 provide for the following:
- 2 (1) Eligibility and selection criteria for program participation;
- 3 (2) Terms of a service agreement which a recipient shall execute as a condition of receiving4 an award:
- 5 (3) Repayment provisions for a recipient who fails to fulfill the service requirement;
- 6 (4) Forgiveness options for death or disability of a recipient;
- 7 (5) An appeal process for students denied participation or ordered to repay awards; and
- 8 (6) Additional provisions as necessary to implement this section.
- 9 (f) The commission shall report annually by December 1, 2014, and annually thereafter, to
- 10 the Legislative Oversight Commission on Health and Human Resources Accountability and the
- 11 Legislative Oversight Commission on Education Accountability on the number of award recipients
- 12 and all other matters relevant to the provisions of this section.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to expand the eligible master's and doctoral level programs for which a nursing scholarship may be awarded.
