2 (b) When the goods are damaged or deteriorated in quality or where merchandise is sold in  
3 ~~bona fide~~ clearance sales, and, in each case, merchandise is advertised, marked and sold as such;

4 (c) By an officer acting under the orders of any court;

5 (d) In an endeavor in good faith to meet the legal prices of a competitor as ~~herein~~ defined in  
6 this article selling the same ~~article~~ product or item of merchandise, in the same locality or trade area;

7 (e) For charitable purposes or to relief agencies;

8 (f) Where merchandise is sold on contract to departments of the government or governmental  
9 institutions.

10 (g) By a wholesaler, distributor or retailer for all sales of motor fuel, as defined in section  
11 two, article fourteen-c, chapter eleven of this code.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to add sales of motor fuel to the list of products exempted from unfair trade practices.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
