10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 3, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,  
11 relating to authorizing the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a  
12 legislative rule relating to emission standards for hazardous air pollutants.

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

14 That article 3, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and  
15 reenacted to read as follows:

16 **ARTICLE 3. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL**  
17 **PROTECTION TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

18 **§64-3-1. Department of Environmental Protection.**

19 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 25, 2014, authorized under the  
20 authority of section four, article five, chapter twenty-two of this code, relating to the Department of  
21 Environmental Protection (emission standards for hazardous air pollutants, [45 CSR 34](#)), is

1 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants.
