A BILL to amend and reenact article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,  
relating to authorizing the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a  
legislative rule relating to public water systems.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and  
reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN  
RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-5-1. Department of Health and Human Resources.**

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the August 1, 2014, authorized under the  
authority of section four, article one, chapter sixteen, of this code, modified by the Department of  
Health and Human Resources to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review

- 1 Committee and refiled in the State Register on October 23, 2014, relating to the Department of
- 2 Health and Human Resources (public water systems, [64 CSR 3](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to public water systems.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
