Senate Bill No. 183
(By Senator Snyder)

[Introduced January 14, 2015; referred to the Committee on Government Organization; and then
to the Committee on the Judiciary.]

A BILL to amend and reenact article 2, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
relating to authorizing the Office of Technology to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
the procedures for sanitization, retirement and disposition of information technology
equipment.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 2, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and
reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 2. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION TO
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-2-1. Office of Technology.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 30, 2014, authorized under the
authority of section four, article six, chapter five-a of this code, modified by the Office of

1 Technology to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled
2 in the State Register on October 3, 2014, relating to the Office of Technology (procedures for
3 sanitization, retirement and disposition of information technology equipment, [163 CSR 1](#), is
4 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Office of Technology to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the Procedures for Sanitization, Retirement and Disposition of Information Technology Equipment.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
