9 A BILL to amend and reenact article 7, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,  
10 relating to authorizing the Alcohol Beverage Control Commission to promulgate a legislative  
11 rule relating to nonintoxicating beer licensing and operations procedures.

12 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

13 That article 7, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and  
14 reenacted to read as follows:

15 **ARTICLE 7. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF TAX AND REVENUE TO**  
16 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

17 **§64-7-1. Alcohol Beverage Control Commission.**

18 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 1, 2014, authorized under the  
19 authority of section twenty-two, article sixteen, chapter eleven of this code, modified by the Alcohol  
20 Beverage Control Commission to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review  
21 Committee and refiled in the State Register on November 6, 2014, relating to the Alcohol Beverage

- 1 Commission (nonintoxicating beer licensing and operations procedures, [176 CSR 1](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Alcohol Beverage Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Nonintoxicating Beer Licensing and Operations Procedures.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
