## Senate Bill No. 195

(By Senator Snyder)

[Introduced January 14, 2015; referred to the Committee on Natural Resources; and then to the Committee on the Judiciary.]

A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the Conservation Committee to promulgate a legislative rule relating to financial assistance programs.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

## ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

## **§64-9-1.** Conservation Committee.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 28, 2014, authorized under the 2 authority of section four-a, article twenty-one-a, chapter nineteen of this code, modified by the 3 Conservation Committee to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee 4 and refiled in the State Register on November 21, 2014, relating to the Conservation Committee 5 (financial assistance programs, 63 CSR 2), is authorized.
