

**Senate Bill No. 195**

A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the Conservation Committee to promulgate a legislative rule relating to financial assistance programs.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO  
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Conservation Committee.**

1           The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 28, 2014, authorized under the  
2 authority of section four-a, article twenty-one-a, chapter nineteen of this code, modified by the  
3 Conservation Committee to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee  
4 and refiled in the State Register on November 21, 2014, relating to the Conservation Committee  
5 (financial assistance programs, 63 CSR 2), is authorized.
