19	The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 1, 2014, authorized under the
20	authority of section seven, article twelve-e, chapter nineteen of this code, modified by the
21	Department of Agriculture to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee

- 1 and refiled in the State Register on December 30, 2014, relating to the Commissioner of Agriculture
- 2 (industrial hemp, <u>61 CSR 29</u>), is authorized.
