Senate Bill No. 227
(By Senator Snyder)

[Introduced January 14, 2015; referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.]

A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the Secretary of State to promulgate a legislative rule relating to a schedule of fees for notaries public.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Secretary of State.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 1, 2014, authorized under the authority of section twenty-five, article four, chapter thirty-nine, of this code, modified by the Secretary of State to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on September 9, 2014, relating to the Secretary of State (schedule of fees for notaries public, [153 CSR 50](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Secretary of State to promulgate a legislative rule relating to a schedule of fees for notaries public.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
