14	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new
15	section, designated§25-1-5a, to read as follows:
16	ARTICLE 1. ORGANIZATION, INSTITUTIONS AND CORRECTIONS MANAGEMENT.
17	§25-1-5a. Mutual aid agreements.
18	The commissioner may enter into agreements to provide for the rendering of mutual aid to
19	the political subdivisions of this state, other states, to generally cooperate with the federal
20	government and to provide for the common defense, protect the public peace, health and safety and
21	to preserve the lives and property of the people of this state.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Commissioner of Corrections to enter into mutual aid agreements.
