17	§24-6-6c. Authorization of additional local 911 fees.	
18	(a) Effective July 1, 2015, any county commission may authorize the collection of an	
19	additional enhanced county 911 fee not to exceed \$1 per month per wireless subscriber and fee not	
20	to exceed \$1per month per each voice over Internet protocol subscriber who resides in that county.	
21	Such fees are in addition to fees outlined in section six (b) of this article; however, the additional	

- 1 fees assessed herein shall be collected by the Public Service Commission in the same manner as
- 2 provided in this article for other fees and returned specifically to the county which authorized the
- 3 additional fee.
- 4 (b) All additional funds received pursuant to this section shall be restricted in use, specifically
- 5 dedicated to the operation, maintenance and personnel costs associated with the operational needs
- 6 of the county 911 center of the county authorizing and generating such additional fees.

NOTE: This bill authorizes county commissions to authorize the collection of additional fees, not to exceed \$1 per subscriber of wireless phones and Internet voice over protocol lines.
