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10	A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
11	designated §9-5-24, relating to requiring the Department of Health and Human Resources
12	review rates paid to health care providers.
13	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
14	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new
15	section, designated §9-5-24, to read as follows:
16	ARTICLE 5. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS.
17	§9-5-24. Review and adjustment of rates paid to care providers.
18	(a) The Department of Health and Human Resources shall perform a review of rates it pays
19	to health care providers and the rates its managed care contractors pay to health care providers. The
20	reviews shall be undertaken every two years. In doing the reviews the department shall determine
21	the cost to the provider type for providing health care services on behalf of the department or the
22	managed care contractor in comparison to the amounts paid.

(b) The results of the rate review in subsection (a) of this section may not compel an increase
 in the health care rates paid but shall be used by the department to determine if the current rates are
 adequate to assure access to health care services provided under the Medicaid program.

4 (c) The department shall provide copies of the rate review findings and work papers to the
5 Joint Committee on Government and Finance within thirty days of completing the review and at the
6 same time publically post the reports and work papers on its website.

7 (d) The department shall provide the Joint Committee on Government and Finance a
8 schedule of when various rate reviews by provider and service type will be performed within thirty
9 days of the effective date of this section. The schedule shall be updated and resubmitted every year
10 after that.

(e) If the department does not comply with this section the Joint Committee on Government and Finance may conduct an independent rate review on its own and the Department of Health and Human Resources and its managed care contractors shall fully cooperate. The department shall reimburse the Joint Committee on Government and Finance for all expenses and costs incurred in conducting the review. The findings and work papers shall be posted on the legislative website, if the review is conducted by the Joint Committee on Government and Finance.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require the Department of Health and Human Resources to review rates it pays to care providers.
