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10	A BILL to amend and reenact §60A-3-301 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended; and to	
11	amend said code by adding thereto a new section, designated §60A-3-301a, all relating to	
12	setting registration fees for manufacture, distribution, dispensing and conducting research	
13	of controlled substances; and providing certain boards with rule-making authority.	
14	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:	
15	That §60A-3-301 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and	
16	reenacted; and that said code be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated §60A-3-301a,	
17	all to read as follows:	
18	ARTICLE 3. REGULATION OF MANUFACTURE, DISTRIBUTION AND DISPENSING	
19	OF CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES.	
20	§60A-3-301. Rules; fees.	
21	(a) The state Board of Pharmacy shall promulgate rules and charge fees relating to the	
22	registration and control of the manufacture and distribution of controlled substances within this state.	
23	and Each department, board, or agency of this state which licenses or registers practitioners	
24	authorized to dispense any a controlled substance shall promulgate rules and charge fees relating to	
25	the registration and control of the dispensing of controlled substances within this state by those	
26	practitioners licensed or registered by such that department, board, or agency.	

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The state Board of Pharmacy or the department, board or agency shall collect the following
annual registration fees from persons who manufacture, distribute, dispense or conduct research with
controlled substances: For registration of a manufacturer, \$50; for registration of a wholesaler, \$50;
for registration of a retailer, \$15; for registration of a hospital or clinic, \$15; and for registration of
a research institution, \$5.

6 §60A-3-301a. Fee schedule.

7 Until amended, modified, repealed or replaced by legislative rule, the state Board of 8 Pharmacy or any department, board or agency shall collect the following annual registration fees 9 from persons who manufacture, distribute, dispense or conduct research with respect to controlled 10 substances:

- 11 (1) \$50 for registration of a manufacturer;
- 12 (2) \$50 for registration of a wholesaler;
- 13 (3) \$50 for registration of a hospital or clinic;
- 14 (4) \$25 for registration of a medical examiner;
- 15 (5) \$25 for registration of a teaching or research institution;
- 16 (6) \$25 for registration of a nursing home or an extended care facility; and
- 17 (7) \$15 for registration of a dispenser.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to set fees for the manufacture, distribution, dispensing and conducting research of controlled substances. The bill grants rule-making authority to certain boards.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.

§60A-3-301a is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
