1 AN ACT to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, 2 designated §59-1-2c, relating to creating Young Entrepreneur Reinvestment Act; waiving 3 certain fees for individuals under thirty creating certain business organizations, and expire 4 the waiver of those fees. Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia: 1 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new 2 section, designated §59-1-2c, to read as follows: ARTICLE 1. FEES AND ALLOWANCES. §59-1-2c. Young Entrepreneur Reinvestment Act; certain fees waived. 1 (a) Beginning on July 1, 2016, a person who is under the age of thirty who resides within 2 West Virginia is exempt from paying the fees provided in section two of this article for filing: 3 (1) Articles of incorporation of a domestic, for-profit corporation, for which he or she is an 4 incorporator; 5 (2) Articles of incorporation of a domestic, nonprofit corporation for which he or she is an 6 incorporator: 7 (3) Articles of organization of a domestic limited liability company, for which he or she is a 8 member; 9 (4) Agreement of a domestic general partnership, for which he or she is a partner; or 10 (5) Certificate of a domestic limited partnership, for which he or she is a partner.
