1	A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new article			
2	designated §17A-6F-1, §17A-6F-2 and §17A-6F-3, all relating to authorizing the			
3	commissioner of the division of motor vehicles to issue a special motor vehicle collector			
4	license plate; defining terms; establishing requirements for issuance; establishing fees			
5	and providing requirements and conditions for use of the plate on a collector motor vehicle.			
	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:			
6	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted by adding			
7	thereto a new article, designated §17A-6F-1, §17A-6F-2 and §17A-6F-3, all to read as follows:			
	ARTICLE 6F. MOTOR VEHICLE COLLECTOR LICENSE PLATE.			
	§17A-6F-1. Definitions.			
1	For the purposes of this article:			
2	"Collector motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle that is more than twenty-five years old			
3	and is owned solely as a collector's item.			
4	"Motor vehicle collector" or "collector" means any person who holds a motor vehicle			
5	collector license plate.			
	§17A-6F-2. Special motor vehicle collector license plate; qualifications; fees.			
1	(a) The commissioner may issue special motor vehicle collector license plates in			
2	accordance with this article. To qualify for and receive a motor vehicle collector license plate, an			
3	applicant must meet the following requirements:			
4	(1) Be a permanent resident of the State of West Virginia;			
5	(2) Submit an application in a form specified by the commissioner;			
6	(3) Own a collector motor vehicle;			
7	(4) Present proof of ownership of the vehicle or a bill of sale; and

10	(b) Once a person is issued a motor vehicle collector license plate pursuant to this article
11	motor vehicle, the person is not required to continue to own a collector motor vehicle to maintain
12	or renew the special motor vehicle collector license plate.
13	(c) A motor vehicle collector license plate issued pursuant to this article is valid for a period
14	of one year from the date of issue. A collector may hold multiple special motor vehicle collector
15	license plates at the same time.
16	(d) The fee for a special motor vehicle collector plate is \$60, and the annual renewal fee
17	is \$60. The fee for an additional special motor vehicle collector plate is \$30, and the annual fee
18	to renew is \$30 per plate.
	§17A-6F-3. Use of collector motor vehicles with a motor vehicle collector plate.
1	(a) A collector motor vehicle may be operated upon the streets and highways displaying
2	a motor vehicle collector plate if:
3	(1) The vehicle displays a motor vehicle collector license plate, issued pursuant to this
4	article; and
5	(2) The vehicle has been owned by the collector for thirty days or less, or the vehicle has
6	a certificate of title in the name of the collector issued in this state.
7	(b) A collector motor vehicle may not be used for general transportation and may only be
8	used for purposes allowed for the use of antique motor vehicles provided in subsection (b), section
9	three-a, article ten, chapter seventeen-a of this code.
10	(c) A collector may transfer a motor vehicle collector license plate among multiple collector
11	motor vehicles under his or her ownership: Provided, That the collector operates each vehicle in
12	compliance with the requirements of this article.
