### **Senate Bill 224**

1 A BILL to amend and reenact article 10, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as  
 2 amended, relating to authorizing the Office of Miners’ Health, Safety and Training to  
 3 promulgate a legislative rule relating to substance abuse screening standards and  
 4 procedures.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

1 That article 10, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended  
 2 and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 10. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TO  
 PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-10-1. Office of Miners’ Health, Safety and Training.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 30, 2015, authorized under the  
 2 authority of section fourteen, article six, chapter twenty-two-a, of this code, relating to the Office  
 3 of Miners’ Health, Safety and Training (substance abuse screening standards and procedures,  
 4 56 CSR 19), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Office of Miners’ Health, Safety and Training to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Substance Abuse Screening Standards and Procedures.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
