- A BILL to amend and reenact §11-10-14a of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
 relating to including on the state personal income tax return a checkoff option to donate
- 3 some or all of any tax refund to the Cedar Lakes Foundation Checkoff Program.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 That §11-10-14a of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and 2 reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 10. WEST VIRGINIA TAX PROCEDURE AND ADMINISTRATION ACT.

§11-10-14a. Expiration of Tax refund check-off programs.

- (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, All voluntary tax refund
 check-off programs shall expire and <u>do</u> not apply to any personal income tax returns required to
 be filed after June 30, 1991: *Provided,* That if any such program has an earlier expiration date
 specifically provided by law, such earlier expiration date shall apply.
- 1 (b) Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this section, each West Virginia individual income
- 2 tax return form shall contain a designation as follows:
- 3 <u>"Cedar Lakes Foundation Checkoff Program" "Donations to be used as a source of</u>
- 4 revenue for the operation of the Cedar Lakes Foundation."
- 5 <u>"Check () if you wish to designate \$1, \$5, \$10 or more of your tax refund for this program.</u>
- 6 If joint return, check () if spouse wishes to designate \$1, \$5, \$10 or more."
- 7 (c) Each individual taxpayer desiring to contribute to the "Cedar Lakes Foundation
- 8 Checkoff Program" may designate by placing an "X" in the appropriate box on the state income
- 9 tax return form. His or her contribution shall be credited to the program.
- 10 (d) The Tax Department shall determine by July 1 of each year the total amount
- 11 designated pursuant to this section and shall report the amount to the State Treasurer who shall
- 12 credit the amount to the Cedar Lakes Foundation Fund.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to include on the state personal income tax return a checkoff option to donate some or all of any tax refund to the Cedar Lakes Foundation Checkoff Program for the operation of the Cedar Lakes Foundation.
