1 A BILL to repeal §19-25-7 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to insurance
2 policies and such policies impact on liability of landowners or insurers of landowners who
3 open their property for use by others for military, law-enforcement or homeland-defense
4 training or recreational or wildlife propagation purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 25. LIMITING LIABILITY OF LANDOWNERS.

§1. Repeal of section relating to insurance policies.

1 Section seven, article twenty-five, chapter nineteen of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as
2 amended, is hereby repealed.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to repeal §19-25-7.

and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
