A BILL to amend and reenact §15-2-3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
to authorizing the Superintendent of the State Police to hold training classes for
certification to access and use the West Virginia Automated Police Network; authorizing
a fee to be charged for the training; creating a fund in which the fees are to be deposited;
and addressing the use of the funds.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §15-2-3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted
to read as follows:

ARTICLE 2. WEST VIRGINIA STATE POLICE.

§15-2-3. State Police structure; how established; training; special revenue account.

1 (a) The superintendent shall create, appoint and equip the State Police which shall consist 2 of the number of troops, districts and detachments required for the proper administration of the 3 State Police. Each troop, district or detachment shall be composed of the number of officers and 4 members the superintendent determines are necessary to meet operational needs and are 5 required for the efficient operation of the State Police. The superintendent shall establish the 6 general organizational structure of the State Police by interpretive rule in accordance with the 7 provisions of article three, chapter twenty-nine-a of this code. The superintendent shall provide 8 adequate facilities for the training of all members of the State Police and shall prescribe basic 9 training requirements for newly enlisted members. He or she shall also provide advanced or in-10 service training from time to time for all members of the State Police. The superintendent shall 11 hold entry-level training classes for other law-enforcement officers in the state without cost to 12 those officers, except actual expenses for food, lodging and school supplies. The superintendent 13 may hold advanced levels of training classes for other law-enforcement officers in the state for a 14 reasonable daily fee per student not to exceed \$100.

(b) There is hereby created in the State Treasury a special revenue account, which shall
be an interest bearing account, to be known as the Academy Training and Professional

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17 Development Fund. The special revenue account shall consist of training fees, any appropriations 18 that may be made by the Legislature, income from the investment of moneys held in the special 19 revenue account and all other sums available for deposit to the special revenue account from any 20 source, public or private. No expenditures for purposes of this section are authorized from 21 collections except in accordance with the provisions of article three, chapter twelve of this code 22 and upon fulfillment of the provisions set forth in article two, chapter eleven-b of this code. Any 23 balance remaining in the special revenue account at the end of any state fiscal year does not 24 revert to the General Revenue Fund but remains in the special revenue account and shall be 25 used solely in a manner consistent with this article. The superintendent is authorized to expend 26 funds from the account to offset operational and training costs; for building maintenance and 27 repair, for purchases and for equipment repair or replacement for the West Virginia State Police 28 Academy; and to defray necessary expenses incidental to those and other activities associated 29 with law-enforcement training.

30 (c) There is hereby created in the State Treasury a special revenue account, which shall 31 be is an interest bearing account, to be known as the State Police 100th Anniversary Fund. The 32 special revenue account shall consist of merchandise sales, any appropriations that may be made 33 by the Legislature, income from the investment of moneys held in the special revenue account 34 and all other sums available for deposit to the special revenue account from any source, public 35 or private. No expenditures for purposes of this section are authorized from collections except in accordance with the provisions of article three, chapter twelve of this code and upon fulfillment of 36 37 the provisions set forth in article two, chapter eleven-b of this code. Any balance remaining in the special revenue account at the end of any state fiscal year does not revert to the General Revenue 38 39 Fund but remains in the special revenue account and shall be used solely in a manner consistent 40 with this article. The superintendent is authorized to expend funds from the account to offset costs for the 100th Anniversary celebration; for purchasing 100th Anniversary commemorative 41 42 merchandise, equipment, vehicles; and to defray necessary expenses incidental to those and

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43	other activities associated with the 100th Anniversary of the West Virginia State Police. This fund
44	shall expire expires on December 31, 2019 and remaining funds shall be transferred to the
45	Academy Training and Professional Development Fund.
46	(c) The superintendent may hold training classes for certification to access and use the
47	West Virginia Automated Police Network (WEAPON) for a reasonable daily fee per student not to
48	<u>exceed \$100.</u>
49	(d) There is created in the State Treasury a special revenue account, which is an interest
50	bearing account, to be known as the West Virginia State Police Criminal Justice Information
51	Services Fund. The special revenue account shall consist of fees collected for training and
52	certification for access of the West Virginia Automated Police Network (WEAPON) system and
53	any appropriations that may be made by the Legislature, income from the investment of moneys
54	held in the special revenue account and all other sums available for deposit to the special revenue
55	account from any source, public or private. Any balance remaining in the special revenue account
56	at the end of any state fiscal year does not revert to the General Revenue Fund but remains in
57	the special revenue account and may be used solely in a manner consistent with this article. The
58	superintendent is authorized to expend funds from the account to offset operational and training
59	costs; for building maintenance and repair, for purchases and for equipment repair, personal
60	services, software, other associated maintenance costs and to defray necessary expenses
61	incidental to those and other activities associated with the Communications Section.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Superintendent of the State Police to hold training classes for certification to access and use the West Virginia Automated Police Network. It authorizes a fee to be charged for the training, creates a fund in which the fees are to be deposited, and specifies how the funds may be used.
