- A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
 designated §7-1-3pp, relating to authorizing county commissions to add a surcharge to
- 3 county property tax bill of all residential property owners for the service of trash collection;
- 4 and limiting disbursement of moneys collected.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

- 1 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new
- 2 section, designated §7-1-3pp, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 1. COUNTY COMMISSIONS GENERALLY.

§7-1-3pp. Authority to impose surcharge for trash collection.

- 1 (a) The county commission in any county is authorized to impose a surcharge on the
- 2 <u>annual property tax bill of all residential property owners for trash collection.</u>
- 3 (b) For purposes of this section, "residential property" includes all property upon which a
- 4 dwelling is located, including rental units.
- 5 (c) The county surcharge for trash collection shall be imposed on each dwelling owned on
- 6 July 1 of each year and, if more than one unit in a dwelling, on each unit in the dwelling. Further,
- 7 the county surcharge shall be imposed whether the dwelling or unit is occupied or vacant.
- 8 (d) The money collected under this section shall be deposited into a special county fund
- 9 to be used in the county, exclusively, to support waste management efforts. The county
- 10 commission, in consultation with the county solid waste authority, shall determine how to disperse
- 11 the money in the county where it was collected.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize county commissions to impose a surcharge on residential property owners for trash collection and provide for disbursement of money collected.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
