H.B. 2799

- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
- 2 designated §18-2-7d, relating to requiring all high schools to teach fetal development;
- 3 and stating that the requirement may not be construed as approving abortion.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

- 1 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new
- 2 section, designated §18-2-7d, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 2. STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION.

§18-2-7d. Course of study in fetal development.

- 1 The State Board of Education, with the advice of the State Superintendent of Schools,
- 2 shall prescribe a curriculum to teach fetal development. High schools in the state shall include
- 3 in health classes the course of study in fetal development for students. This section may not be
- 4 <u>construed or interpreted to endorse, allow, permit or approve of abortion.</u>

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require all high schools include in their health classes a course in fetal development.

This section is new; therefore, it has been completely underscored.
