1 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as  
 2 amended, relating to authorizing the Secretary of State to promulgate a legislative rule  
 3 relating to the elimination of precinct registration books.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

1 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended  
 2 and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS  
 TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Secretary of State .**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 1, 2015, authorized under the  
 2 authority of section twenty-one, article two, chapter three, of this code, relating to the Secretary  
 3 of State (elimination of precinct registration books, 153 CSR 9), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Secretary of State to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the Elimination of Precinct Registration Books.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
