1 A BILL to amend and reenact article 6, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as
 2 amended, relating to authorizing the State Fire Commission to promulgate a legislative
 3 rule relating to standards for the certification of continuing education of municipal, county
 4 and other public sector building code officials, inspectors and plans examiners.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 That article 6, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
 2 and reenacted to read as follows:

3 **ARTICLE 6. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AFFAIRS AND**
 4 **PUBLIC SAFETY TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-6-1 . State Fire Commission .

5 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on June 29, 2015, authorized under the
 6 authority of section five-b, article three, chapter twenty-nine, of this code, modified by the State
 7 Fire Commission to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and
 8 refiled in the State Register on December 10, 2015, relating to the State Fire Commission
 9 (standards for the certification of continuing education of municipal, county and other public sector
 10 building code officials, inspectors and plans examiners, 87 CSR 7), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the State Fire Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Standards for the Certification of Continuing Education of Municipal, County and Other Public Sector Building Code Officials, Inspectors and Plans Examiners.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
