1 A BILL to amend and reenact article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as
2 amended, relating to authorizing the Department of Health and Human Resources to
3 promulgate a legislative rule relating to the certification of opioid overdose prevention and
4 treatment training programs.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 That article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
2 and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN
RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-5-1. Department of Health and Human Resources.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 27, 2015, authorized under the
2 authority of section four, article one, chapter sixteen, of this code, modified by the Department of
3 Health and Human Resources to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review
4 Committee and refiled in the State Register on September 23, 2015, relating to the Department
5 of Health and Human Resources (the certification of opioid overdose prevention and treatment
6 training programs, 64 CSR 104), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the Certification of Opioid Overdose Prevention and Treatment Training Programs.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
