### **House Bill 4124**

1 A BILL to amend and reenact article 10, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as  
 2 amended, relating to authorizing the Division of Labor to promulgate a legislative rule  
 3 relating to minimum wage and maximum hours.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

4 That article 10, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended  
 5 and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 10. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TO  
 PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-10-1. Division of Labor. Authorization for miscellaneous agencies and boards to  
 promulgate legislative rules.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 31, 2015, authorized under the  
 2 authority of section one, article five-c, chapter twenty-one, of this code, modified by the Division  
 3 of Labor to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in  
 4 the State Register on December 9, 2015, relating to the Division of Labor (minimum wage and  
 5 maximum hours, 42 CSR 8), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Division of Labor to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Minimum Wage and Maximum Hours.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
