2 section, designated §5A-4-7, to read as follows:

### ARTICLE 4. GENERAL SERVICES DIVISION.

#### §5A-4-7. Capitol building access cards for former Legislators.

- 1 (a) For the purposes of this section:
- 2 (1) "Former Legislator" means an individual who has served, but no longer serves, as an
- 3 <u>elected or appointed member of the West Virginia Legislature.</u>
- 4 (2) "Access card" means an electromagnetic or other manner of card that an individual
- 5 must swipe or otherwise use to gain access to a building entrance.
- 6 (b) Upon a former Legislator's request, the division is required to provide the former
- 7 Legislator with an access card that will enable the Legislator to enter the State Capitol building
- 8 through any entrance that is regularly open to personnel and staff of government offices located
- 9 within the State Capitol building.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require the General Services Division to provide former Legislators with access cards to the State Capitol building.
