- A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
 designated §24-3-11, relating to creating a mandatory grace period for the payment of
- 3 water and sewer bills.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new

2 section, designated §24-3-11, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 3. DUTIES AND PRIVILEGES OF PUBLIC UTILITIES SUBJECT TO REGULATIONS OF COMMISSION.

§24-3-11. Grace period for payment of water and sewer bills.

- 1 <u>Any water or sewer facility which is owned or operated by a public or private utility, city,</u>
- 2 incorporated town, municipal corporation or public service district shall give every customer a
- 3 thirty-day grace period for payment of the customer's water and sewer bill before charging a late
- 4 <u>fee.</u>

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require water and sewer facilities to give every customer a thirty-day grace period for payment of their bill before instituting a late fee.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
