INTRODUCED H.B. 2016R2878

A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
designated §18A-4-22, relating to allowing service personnel with NAPT certification
eligibility for professional positions whose primary duties are the supervision of a county
transportation department.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated §18A-4-22, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 4. SALARIES, WAGES AND OTHER BENEFITS.

§18A-4-22. Service Personnel with NAPT Certification eligible for Transportation Management positions.

- 1 <u>If a county board posts professional employee position, whose duties include supervision</u>
- 2 of a county transportation department, any service personnel that possesses a National
- 3 <u>Association for Pupil Transport ("NAPT") certification may be considered for the position.</u>

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to allow employees with an NAPT certification to be eligible for transportation management positions, even if they are posted in the professional service.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
